HOW IS OUR BEEF DIFFERENT? Our cattle eat only what nature designed them to eat—grass. Our cattle wander the farm, foraging and playing together as cows like to do. Because our animals spend their lives free to roam, the beef they yield is lean and very flavourful. Cooking tip: do not overcook!

ABOUT HORMONES and ANTIBIOTICS Our animals never receive growth hormones. If our veterinarian determines that an animal requires emergency antibiotics, that animal is removed from the organic program and is sold elsewhere.
